Rentals are available but there is no discount and a credit card is required.

Prerequisites:	MB Scouts MUST have and READ the Merit Badge Pamphlet; A test will be given some time during the session period.
Other Information:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pre-registration for Merit Badge session by – February 5, 2010. • All youth MUST have a unit permission slip with emergency / medical information. • Full attendance is required to earn the Merit Badge. • MB Scouts MUST bring a Blue Merit Badge application signed by their Scoutmaster. • MB Scouts MUST have and Read the Merit Badge Pamphlet • Walk-ins for the Merit Badge must be there by 9:00 am. • Scouters & Parents are welcome to attend. • A minimum of one adult is required per group of Scouts. • Attendees should bring a bag lunch and drinks. <u>SPECIAL NOTE: COOLERS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE LODGE.
